

NOTES ABOUT CHOOSING WEDDING HYMNS

The careful choosing of hymns that are appropriate to a wedding service cannot be emphasised enough. A hymn should be chosen for its words and not for its tune; most hymns can be played to several different tunes, including ones likely to be known to a fair number of the congregation. Once you've identified a short list of possible hymns, please contact the organist who is playing at your wedding at least 6 weeks before the wedding for him or her to play the tune set and any other alternatives. Those which follow are just some suggestions with the number in the church hymn book:

It is not necessary to have those listed in the places suggested. If, for example, you want to have two "opening" hymns, then one might be switched to a "second" hymn and so on. If you have a request for a hymn that is not in the church hymn books please discuss this with the organist well in advance and certainly before any special service sheet is printed. We have a licence for copying the words of most hymns (CCLI number 494086), but occasionally copyright fees may be due to the publisher or special permissions might be required.
